# Application Procedures for Students Studying at Private expense

# [1.ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS]

Applicants must have completed 12 years of regular school education in countries other than Japan.

- \*[Note] Those who do not meet the above application qualification condition are not eligible for selection.
- \*\*Those who have been enrolled in other Japanese educational institutions for more than one year after coming to Japan are not eligible to apply.

# [2.REQUIREMENTS FOR SELECTION]

- 1. Proficiency in English or Japanese must be demonstrated in one of the following five ways:
  - A) Japanese Language Proficiency Test: N4 or above for April admission, N2 or above for September admission
  - B) Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (Japanese): 200 or above for April admission, 250 or above for September admission
  - C) TOEFL-iBT 52 or above
  - D) TOEIC: 500 or above
  - E) IELTS: 4.5 or above
- 2. A cumulative GPA (Grade Point Average) of 3.0 or higher on the 4.0 scale would be desirable.
- 3. At least one year of experience at a college/university level institution is preferable.
- \*Please be advised that the applicants who got admission from NGU in the categories C), D) & E) mentioned above must be sufficiently proficient in Japanese as below by the day of entrance to NGU.
  - a) be able to read and write Hiragana and Katakana
  - b) be familiar with elementary Kanji through reading introductory textbooks such as "Basic Kanji Book" Vol.1, Bonjinsha Co.
- \*\*After finishing this IJS course, if the applicant wishes to enter our Undergraduate Program, preferably she/he should have N1 of Japanese Language Proficiency Test. In case of Graduate programs, preferably she/he should have N1. (After finishing the IJS course, a recommendation-based special entrance examination system for Nagoya Gakuin University Graduate Programs is available.

- 1) Information sheet on previous Japanese language study and others (FORM 2-1 to 2-7)
- 2) **Digital photograph** with a file size of 1MB or less (Color, clear, sharp and in focus full-face photo with no hat on, taken within 3 months of application, in front of a plain white or light-colored background. Computer-generated photos are not acceptable.)
- 3) Passport copy and a copy of valid visa for Japan (Visas are required only for applicants currently

- residing in Japan) in digital file.
- 4) Two kinds of recommendation letters: FORM 3 (from college professors, employers or others familiar with your background) & FORM 4 (from college professors or Japanese language school instructors who can evaluate your Japanese Language Proficiency)
  - \*FORM 3 and FORM 4 should be written by two different persons.
- 5) **Certificate of Health (FORM 5)** by a qualified physician. (Issued within 3 months from the time of submission of application documents)
- 6) **Certificate of Graduation** from the last attended college/school, or **Certificate of Attendance** from the college presently attending
- 7) **Official transcript** of academic record from the college/school last attended (An original transcript issued within the last 6 months)
- 8) **Official transcript of academic record** from a Japanese language institution, if the applicant is currently attending one.
- 9) **Financial Evidence** (Please choose one from three choices;  $(1) \sim (3)$ )
  - ① Certificate of bank balance statement issued by the financial institution verifying enough funds(more than ¥1,000,000) for one-year to study in Japan.
  - \* If a parent or other family member may act as the applicant's financial supporter, please ensure that the following documents are submitted:
    - a) Written pledge signed by the supporter in the prescribed form (FORM 6)
    - b) An official document verifying the relationship to the applicant
    - c) An official document verifying supporter's occupation (Issued within 3 months from the time of submission of application documents)
    - d) Proof of annual income of the supporter (Issued within 3 months from the time of submission of application documents)
  - (2) Scholarship document showing sufficient funds and the scholarship period.
  - (3) Loan document showing sufficient funds and the loan period.

    In case a guarantor living in Japan supports the applicant, the documents below are needed.
    - a) Letter of Guarantee (FORM 7)
    - b) Guarantor's Certificate of residential tax payment (源泉徵収票) or tax payment which shows the amount of total income (納税証明書)
    - c) Guarantor's certificate of office employment (在籍証明書) or Registration certificate of the company (登記簿謄本)
- 10) Official document verifying Japanese or English Language Proficiency
- 11) Receipt of the remittance for application fee (FORM 8)

- \* Official documents from China, 6) Certificate of Graduation or Certificate of Attendance, 7) Official Transcript, 8) Official transcript of academic record from a Japanese language institution and 9) Financial Evidence need
- \* Once application documents are submitted, they cannot be returned to the applicant.

## [7.APPLICATIOIN FEE]

Please remit the amount of ¥10,000 (ten thousand yen in Japanese currency) for application fee during the application period to the bank account of following information. Applicants are responsible for any transfer/wire fees incurred in addition to the ¥10,000 payment and ¥10,000 should be deposited into our bank account in Japanese yen.
